MAKE SURE ALL PROGRAMS ARE OFF

System updates cannot happen during exam.

Auto-update should be turned off for all programs before starting online proctoring.

Proctor will end exam if a program starts running in the background.





ANTI-VIRUS SOFTWARE CAN INTERFERE

Anti-virus software can prevent the online proctoring program from running on your system. In order to complete your online exam, all programs including anti-virus must be closed.

POP-UP BLOCKERS MUST BE TURNED OFF

Pop-up blockers in your internet browser will prevent pop-ups and notifications from your exam. Ensure the blocker is turned off so you can run all programs required for your exam.
